A government parastatal in East Africa established in 1965, with a mission to promote, establish, equip and manage libraries in the country. Also operating several e-Resource Centers across various counties.

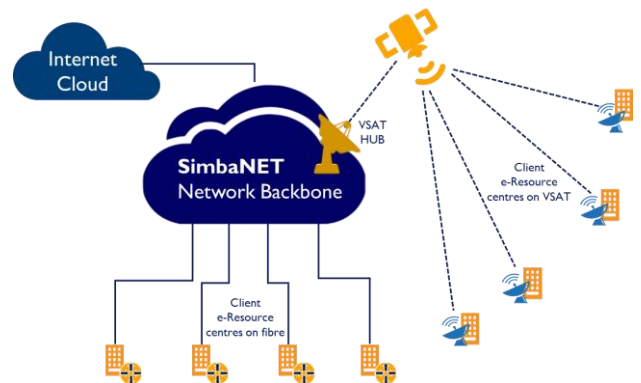
Through various reading campaigns, the organization provides opportunities for communities to enhance their reading and information seeking habits, and therefore sustain literacy.

- Also provisioned WAN on MPLS connecting e-Resource Centers to HQ
- Both Fiber and VSAT used for access technology
